ROLE	DESCRIPTION	DBS
Book shop volunteers	This is a forward facing customer service role at our second hand bookshop. This will be on a Thursday only. Hours will be either 9am-1pm or 1pm to 5pm or 9am-5pm. This role will include stocking shelves, looking up prices and assisting member of the public with their purchases. Training will be provided on the Services offered by The Wish Centre.	No
Refuge Support volunteers	To support and assist refuge staff in their day to day activities. This is a varied role and will include practical assistance & support, children's and adult's activities & befriending with a view to increasing confidence and re-building the lives of the families. Training will be provided.	Yes
Mentors and/or Befrienders	We require both male and female volunteers to offer both practical & emotional support to our adult clients, victims & perpetrators. This will include practical help, eg. form filling, support to appointments and short courses and also building a professional rapport to enable a client to reduce isolation, gain confidence and re-build their lives.	Yes
Fundraising support	To develop and organise small fundraising activities such as online auctions, raffles, supermarket bag packing etc. This role will be supporting our Community Fundraiser and will include some admin tasks.	No
Beauty/Holistic Therapists	To run a group in refuge to allow the Mums some valuable down time and pampering. Manicures, pedicures, hand massages.	Yes
Perpetrator Group support	To support our Perpetrator team in delivering our Make the Change programme. This will include supporting the facilitator to set up equipment for the group, individual support for Clients with literacy difficulties & other activities within the group.	Yes
Court Support	To support Client's to Court hearings. To provide emotional and practical support at hearings in the Family & Criminal Courts. Drivers licence and transport would be beneficial (expenses paid).	Yes
